DRESS CODE - STUDENTS

POLICY

Rationale

A uniform dress code reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community, and assists in developing pride in representing their school. Issues of equality, health and safety, and expense are also factors that contribute to the establishment of the uniform policy.

Aims

- To promote equality amongst all students.
- To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school.
- To provide durable clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment.
- To maintain and enhance the positive image of the school in the community.

Implementation

- A uniform policy has been developed that we believe provides choice for the students, allows for students to safely engage in the many varied school activities, and caters for the financial constraints of families.
- The uniform policy applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions.
- Summer and winter uniforms, as well as sports uniforms will be prescribed, and are required to be worn.
- White or navy coloured undershirts/T shirts may be worn
- Only the official school jacket may be worn.
- Students are encouraged to wear KSC logo summer hats or hats of their own choice but should only be worn outside.
- All items of school uniform are expected to be kept and worn in a presentable manner. Skirts and shorts length should consider practical coverage for the various activities of the school day. Students wearing uniform in an unacceptable fashion will be considered to be out of uniform.
- If a student is out of uniform for any reason they should report to the sub school office prior to the first class of the day. Where possible, a replacement article will be provided. Where this is not possible, a uniform pass will be provided on computer.
- School Council requires the Principal be responsible for implementation of the uniform policy in a manner consistent with the Student Code of Conduct.
- Arrangements can be made to supply uniforms via State Schools Relief for families experiencing economic hardship.

Polo shirt – short sleeved	KSC logo white or royal blue polo shirt.
Polo shirt - long sleeved	KSC logo white
Windcheater Years 7-9	KSC logo V neck navy blue windcheater.
Windcheater Years 10-12	KSC logo VCE windcheater – navy.
Traditional Pants	Tailored or loose fit navy pants. Academy style. Pants should be neatly hemmed.
Fitted Pants	KSC logo tailored fashion cut, stretch navy pants. Pants should be neatly hemmed.
Shorts	KSC logo tailored or loose fit navy shorts.
Summer & winter skirts	KSC summer fabric skirt or KSC winter fabric kilt.
Summer dress/Tunic	KSC summer fabric dress/tunic.
Socks	White or black plain socks, socks are compulsory.
Shoes	Black school shoes – lace up or buckle.
Tights	Navy blue tights are an alternative to socks.
Scarf	Navy blue scarf only.
Beanie	Plain navy or black, no logos. Outside only.
Gloves	Navy, black or grey gloves. Outside only.
Sports uniform	The sports uniform is compulsory for students in years 7-10. It consists of navy track pants or KSC logo navy shorts to be worn with a KSC logo royal blue & navy sports polo top. This is the change of clothes that students must bring for Physical Education classes.
Jacket	KSC jackets only allowed. Can be worn in class
School rugby jumper	KSC logo rugby jumper. Can be worn in class
Summer Hats	KSC logo hat/s or personal choice to be worn outside and for PE when appropriate. Outside only.
